Communist Duplicity

ENERAL EISENHOWER'S arrival in Europe and the new announcements about the British and American defence programs are being hotly denounced by all Communist propagandists as "feverish preparations for unleashing a new world | war." There have been anti-Eisenhower demonstrations.

That the western nations are seeking war is direct converse of the truth. The whole purpose of the new defensive measures is purely defensive. And the terms of the North Atlantic Treaty are very narrowly and strictly worded, so that its military obligations only come into effect in the event of an actual armed attack on the territory or troops of the members.

The historical facts are in themselves proof of this. For three years after the end of the war the western democracies did nothing to organize any collective security system. They drastically reduced their armed forces and their expenditure on defence. They worked on the assumption that they could count upon a long period of peace.

Meanwhile the Soviet Union-in the words of the British note to Moscow of January 8-"maintained in being vast military forces out of all proportion to those retained by her wartime allies." Not only that but the east European states associated with Russia were welded into close military alliance. The ex-enemy states among them were re-armed. And the armed forces of the whole coalition were closely integrated with those of the Soviet Union.

A formidable military machine was created in eastern Europe. For what purpose? It could not be for defence. For the only other armies in Europe were so small and so unequipped that the very idea of their conducting an effensive against the east was ludicrous.

There could only be two reasons for Russia's preparations. Either this great force was intended for use in an attack on the west, or the intention was to support Soviet diplomacy by such an overwhelming preponderance of armed strength that any western country would be compelled, by the mere possibility of its use, to yield to any and every demand which Moscow chose to make.

There could be no other explanation. And as Russia's preponderance of strength increased, so Russian diplomacy became more openly and avowedly hostile to the west.

The "balance of power" is a phrase which has fallen into disrepute. But a far greater danger comes from a complete unbalance of power, from the possession of overwhelming force by a government intent on extending its territory or its influence. And Soviet Russia has given plenty of evidence of such intention. Despite the pledge of the Anglo-Soviet Treaty of 1943 that it would seek no territorial aggrandizement, it insisted in 1945 in adding thousands of square miles to its territories. It has brought six "independent" European countries under its control. And it has those still unfulfilled "territorial aspirations" in the Middle East on which Molotov laid such stress in his negotiations with Hitler and Von Ribbentrop in 1940.

The unbalance of power in Europe is becoming more and more dangerous. What the western powers are doing is in effect to restore that balance-to create a power situation which Stalin will understand and in which he will be willing to reach reasonable understandings and will not be tempted to use the threat of force as an instrument of policy. The point is that the westerns powers are seeking to restore the balance which has become so dangerously tilted. If there is an "arms race" it was started

by the Soviet Union. That is a historical fact. And it was once discovered as a "law of history" that a test of intention is that peacefully-minded states are always slower and later in military preparations than are aggressively-minded ones. The "discoverer" of that "law" was Josef Stalin. It certainly applies to circum-

stances of today.




