heaping teaspoons of Salada Black Tea in a pint of fresh boiling After six minutes strain liquid into two-quart container. While hot, add of granulated sugar and the juice of 2 lemons. Stir well until sugar dissolved, fill container with cold water. Do not allow tea to cool before adding the cold water; otherwise liquid will become cloudy. Serve with chipped ice.
