

Family Allowances:

Question: Will family allowance be paid for a child above the age of six not attending school?

Answer: Under the Family Allowance Act, the allowance is not payable in respect of a child who, being above the age of six years and physically fit to attend school, fails to attend school or receive the equalent train-

Question: Are adopted children covered?

Answer: Yes, in fact there need not be any legal adoption, just confirmation that the parent or other relative or person is actually maintaining the child.

Question: Do children in institutions receive family allow-

Answer: No. The purpose of the Act is to help parents provide for the health and welfare of their children, not to relieve institutions of their responsibilities. However, where a parent is supporting a child in an institution, the family allowance will be paid.

Question: Will family allowances be paid to people who are already receiving mothers' allowances, dependents allowances, war pensions, unemploymet insurance and workmen's compensation?

Answer: Yes.
